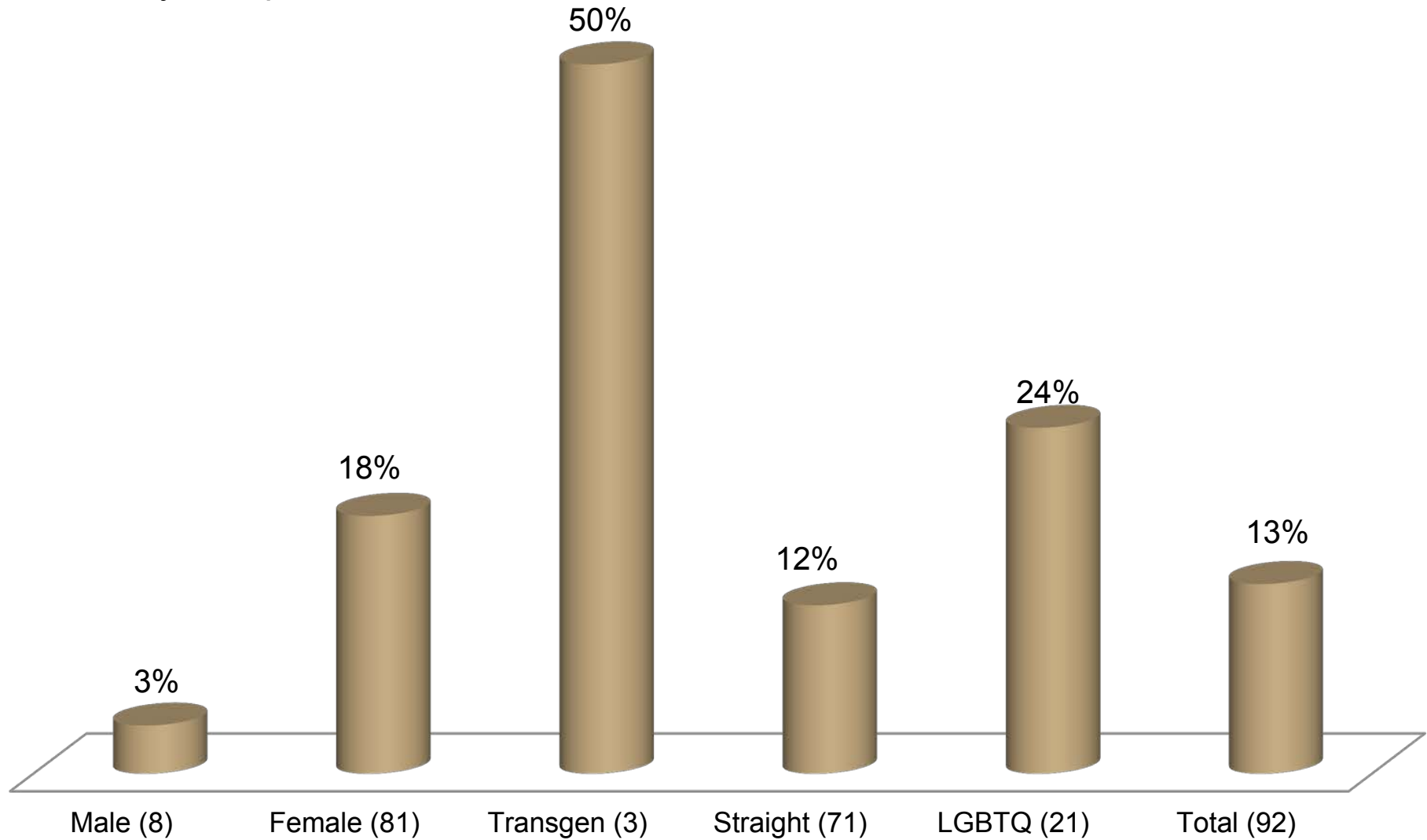

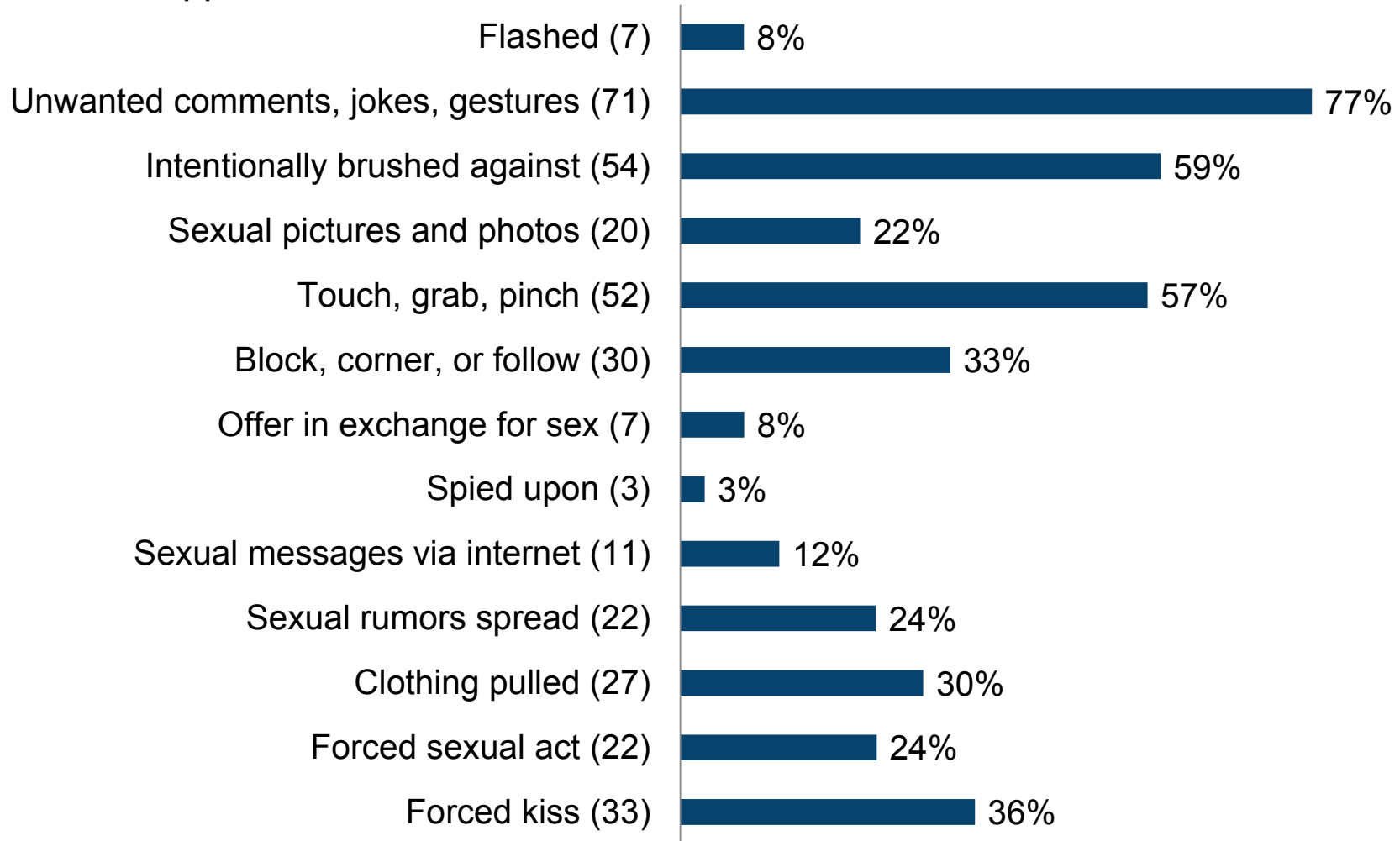

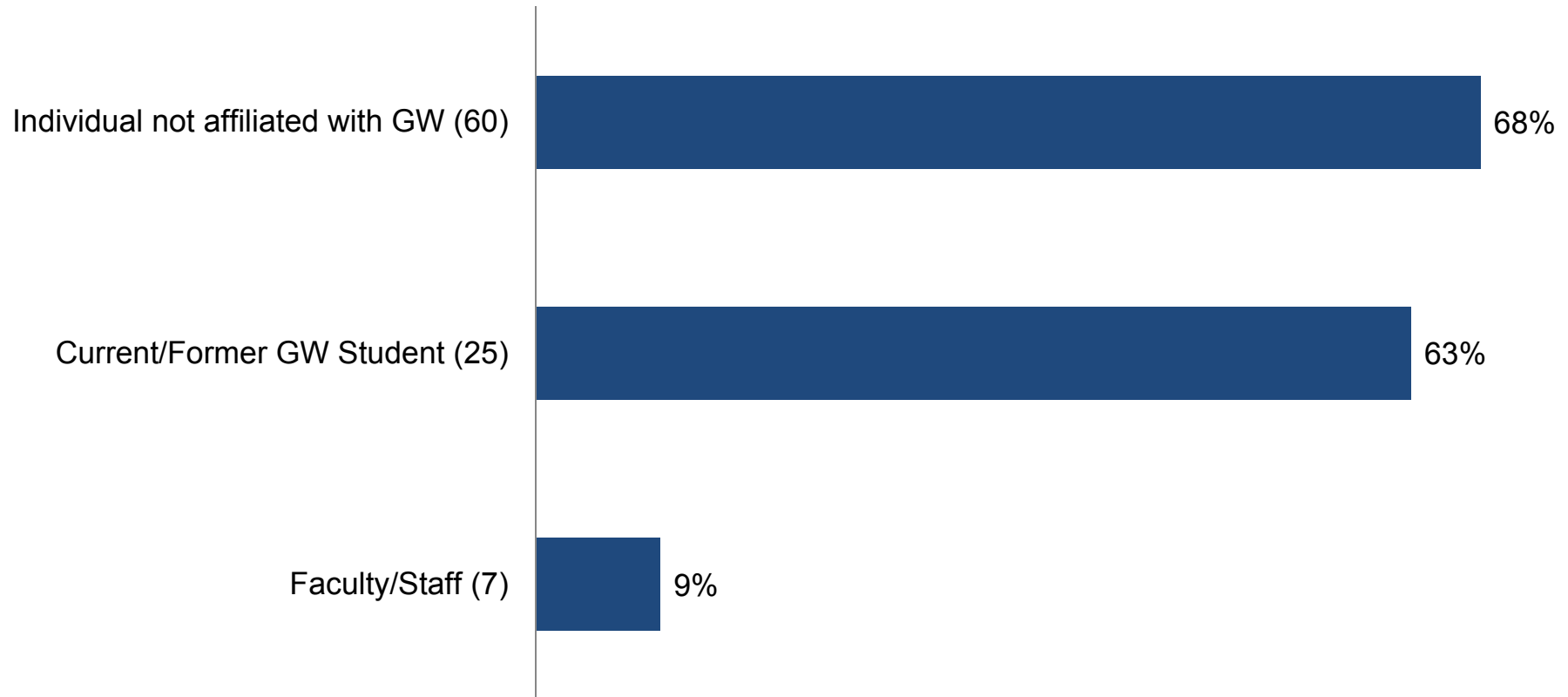

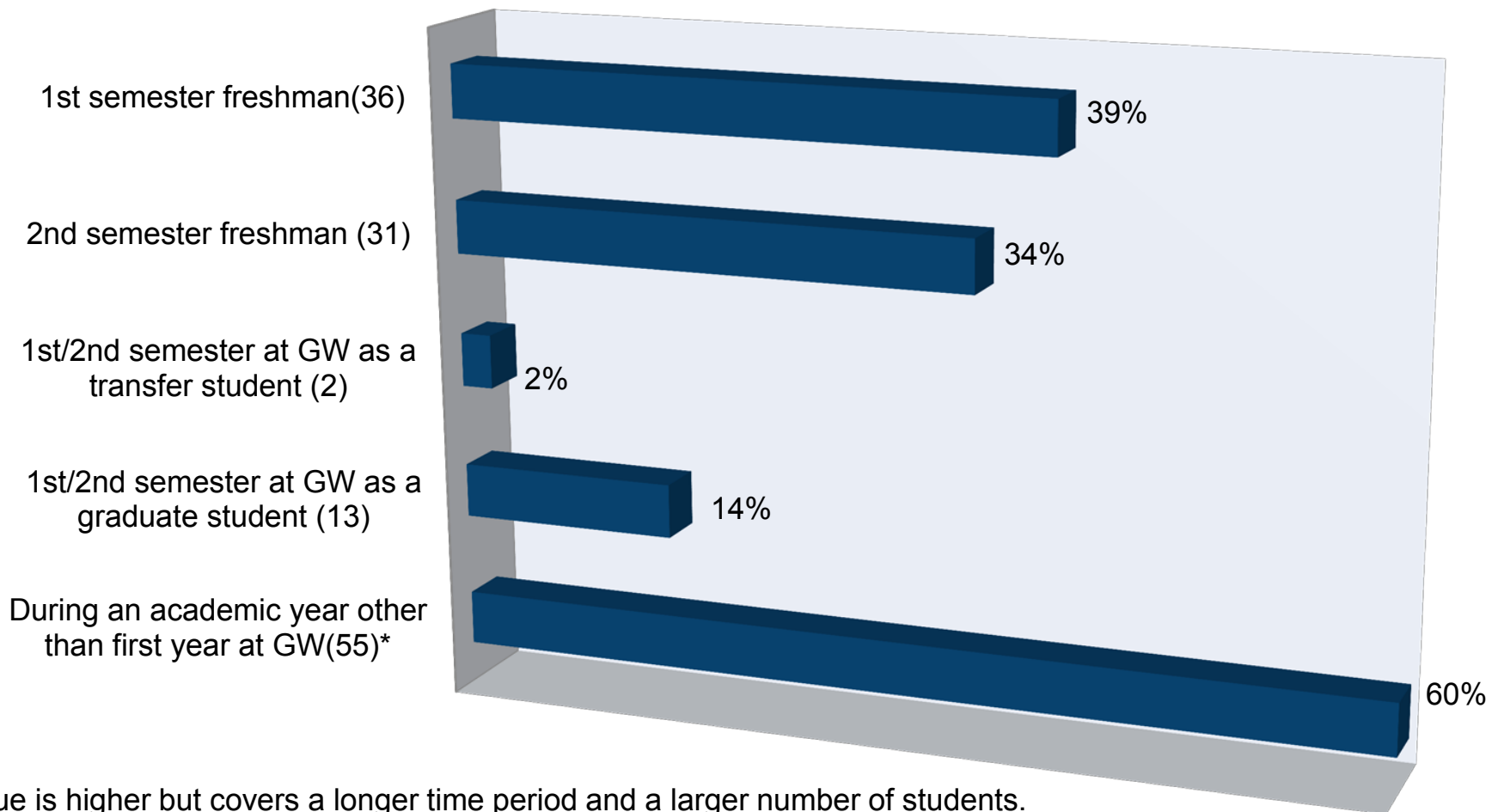

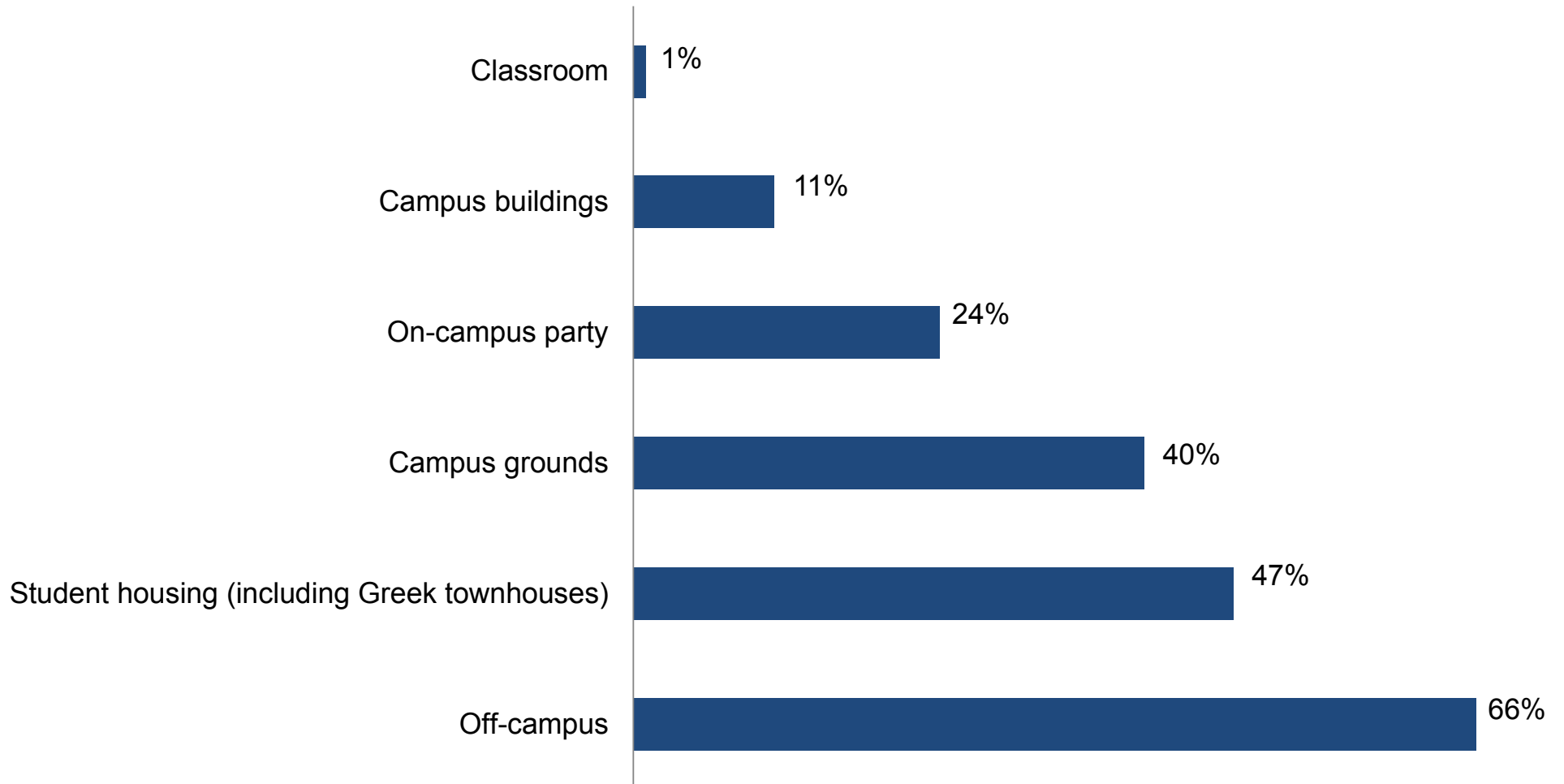

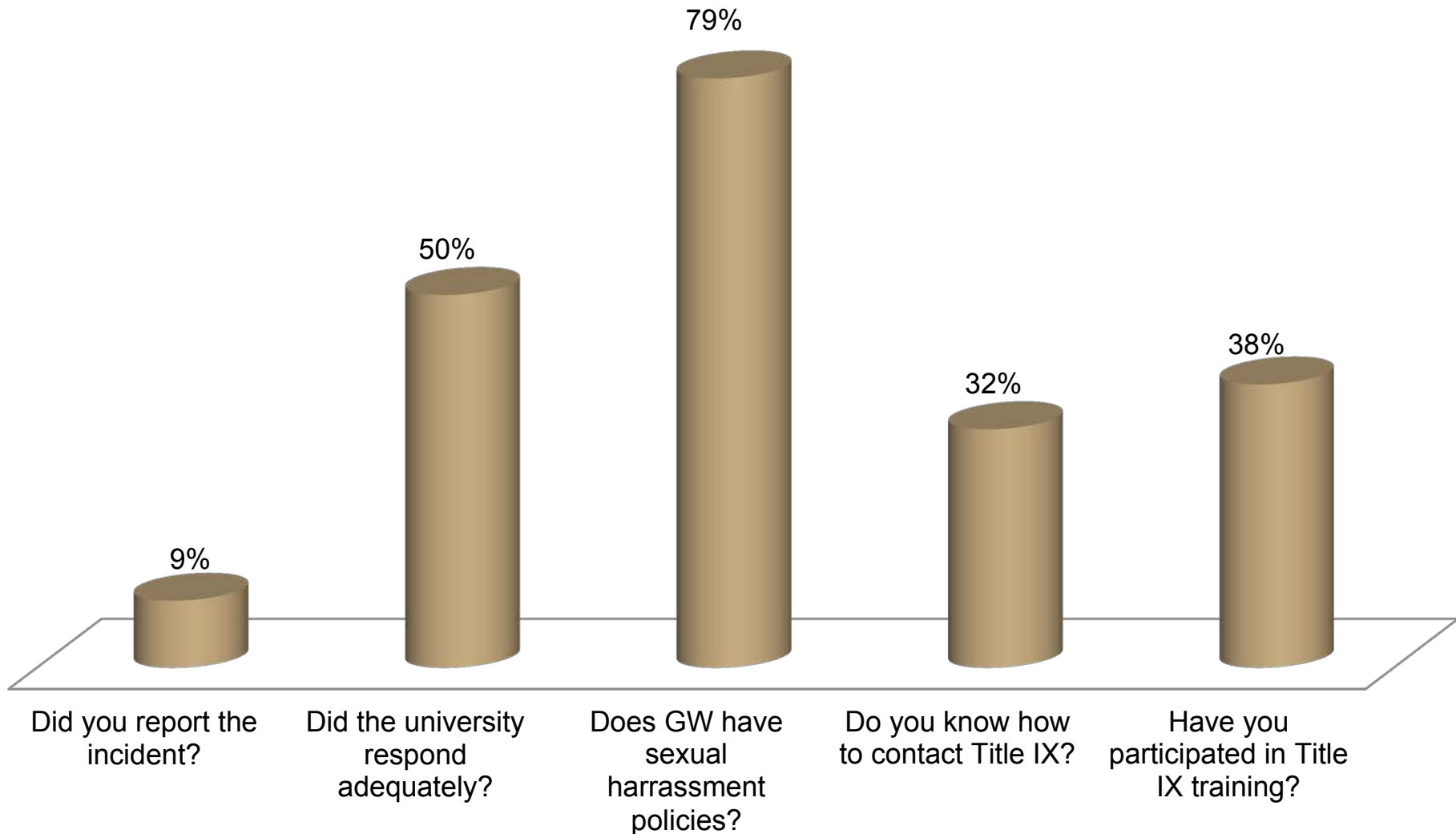

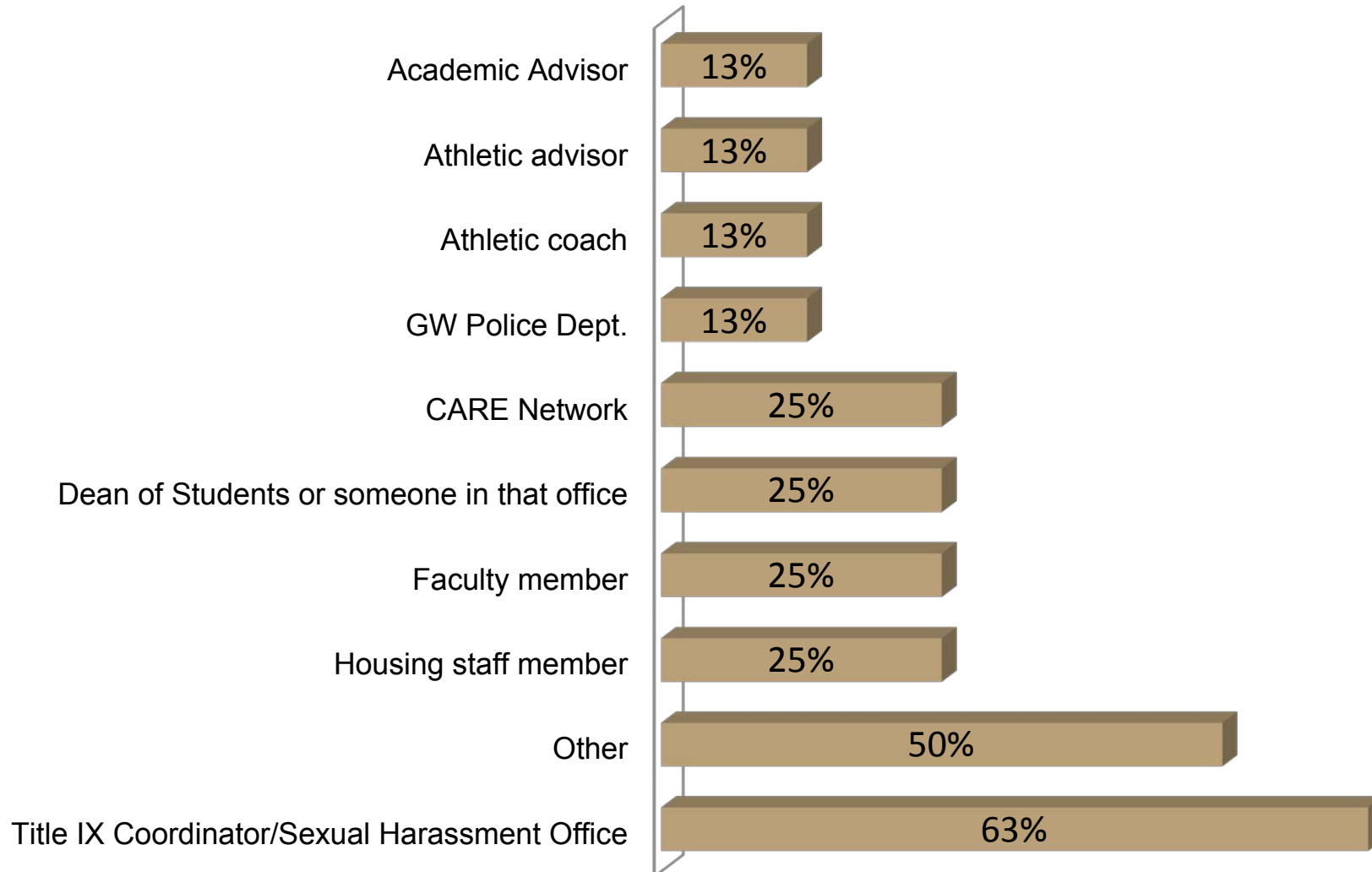

Have you participated in USB orientation/training at GW?

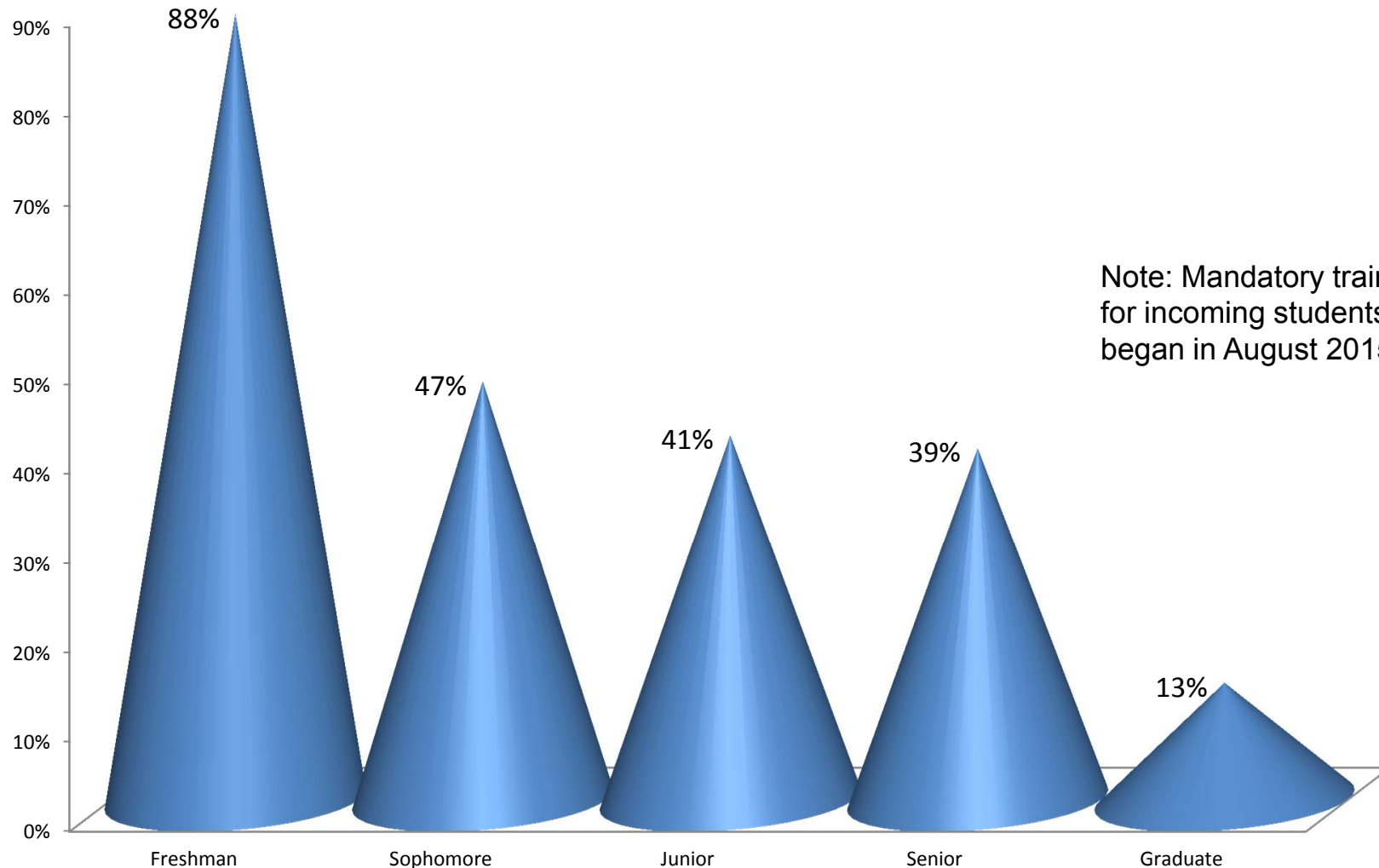


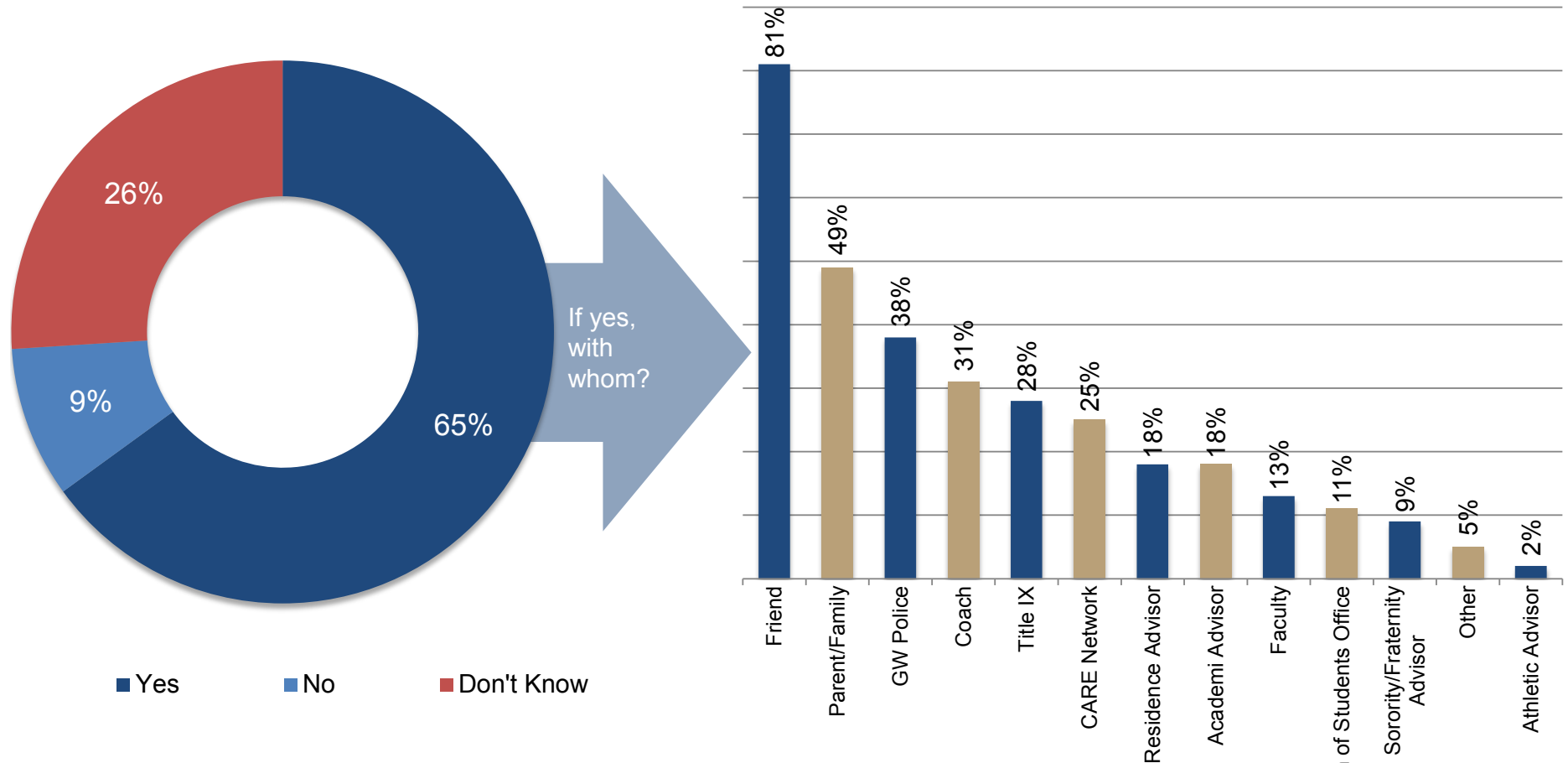

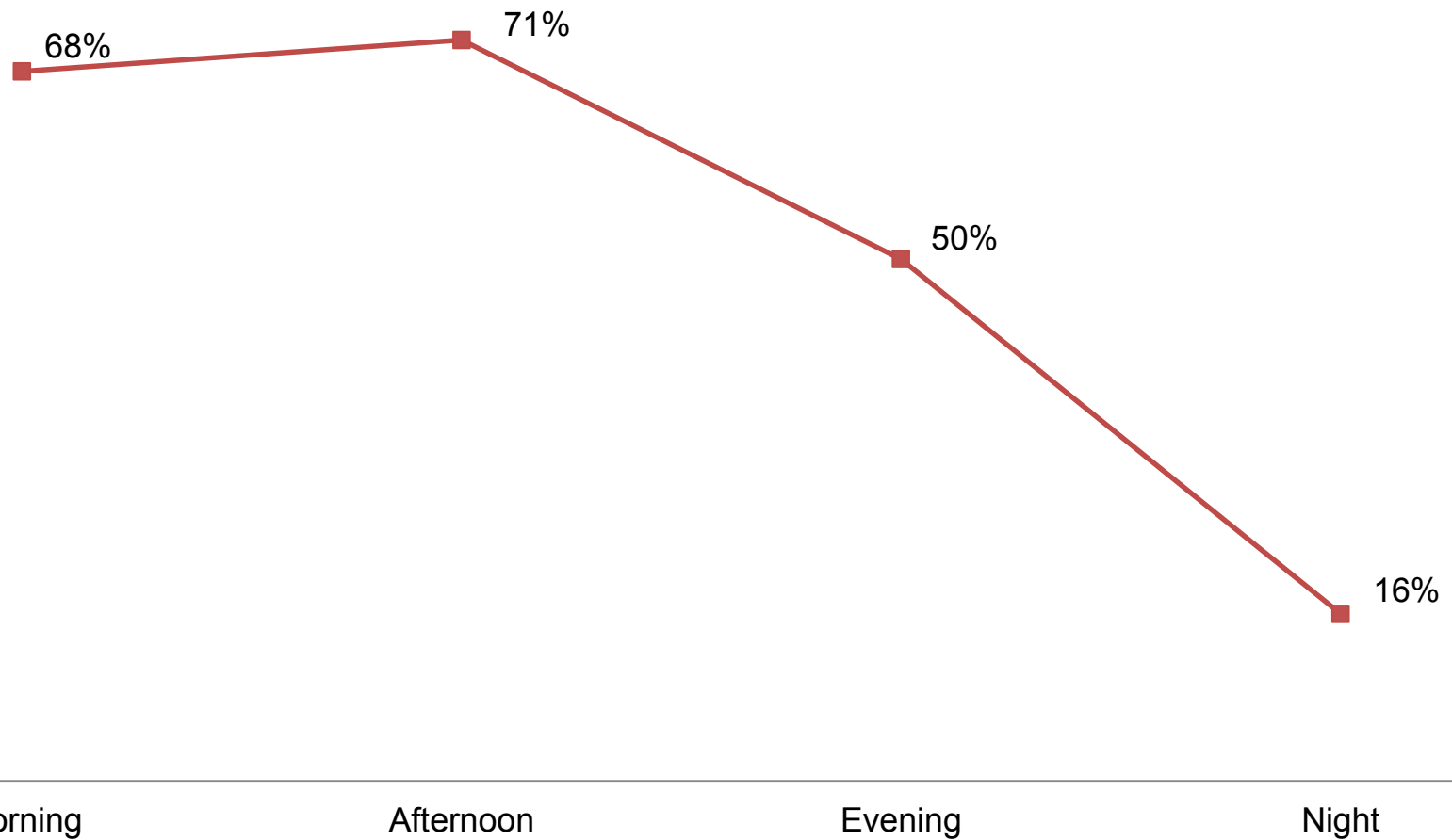
